CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

Warm greetings as the season of Pentecost begins. This year, Pentecost Sunday falls on the same day as World Environment Day, with the theme 'Only One Earth.' We pray with fervent longing, "Come Holy Spirit, Renew the Whole Creation". May we each play our part to protect our fragile world, as climate change continues its devastating effects.



I am grateful for a full and rich month. The weekend retreat with Cape Town diocese Fellowship of Vocation, was a deeply beautiful time with nine retreatants, learning about discernment, contemplative prayer and action, and trying out different ways to pray. Thank you for your prayers.

Coventry Cathedral and the Community of the Cross of Nails (CCN) celebrated their 60th anniversary in the last week of May. Volmoed is one of their two hundred partners worldwide. Together with Mpho Tutu, I spoke at the international online gathering on 'Reconciliation, Justice and the Legacy of Archbishop Desmond Tutu'. If you are interested in receiving links or transcripts for any of the sessions, please let me know.

Our **Wednesday 10.30am Community Prayers** continue, and staff also lead the prayer sessions. At the last one, I told the story of Coventry Cathedral and CCN, and their focus on reconciliation after the Cathedral was bombed in 1940. We prayed the Litany of Reconciliation together, and many of the staff took it with them to use in their churches and home groups. I hope that Volmoed's connection with CCN will be strengthened.

VYLTP (Volmoed Youth Leadership Training Program)

Our good news is that Siyabonga (Siya) Vonco began working part-time for VYLTP a few weeks ago. Siva was one of the founding members of the first VYLTP in 2016. He is a Volmoed trustee and hosts a local Whale Coast Radio morning show. He previously worked for The Rainbow Trust. Siya is working towards our goal to develop a core group of young leaders in greater Hermanus, who will connect more strongly with Volmoed, attend Thursday church services, and volunteer at our VYLTP events. He is working hard to recruit and plan for our next Taizé day event on 25 June. We are also recruiting for a five day workshop on 'Building Beloved Community', with Seth Naicker, in the last week of June. This was usually the first week of the ten week VYLTP program. Siya and I are visiting local clergy to inform them about VYLTP, hoping they will send one or two of their young leaders with most potential. This development is very exciting.
